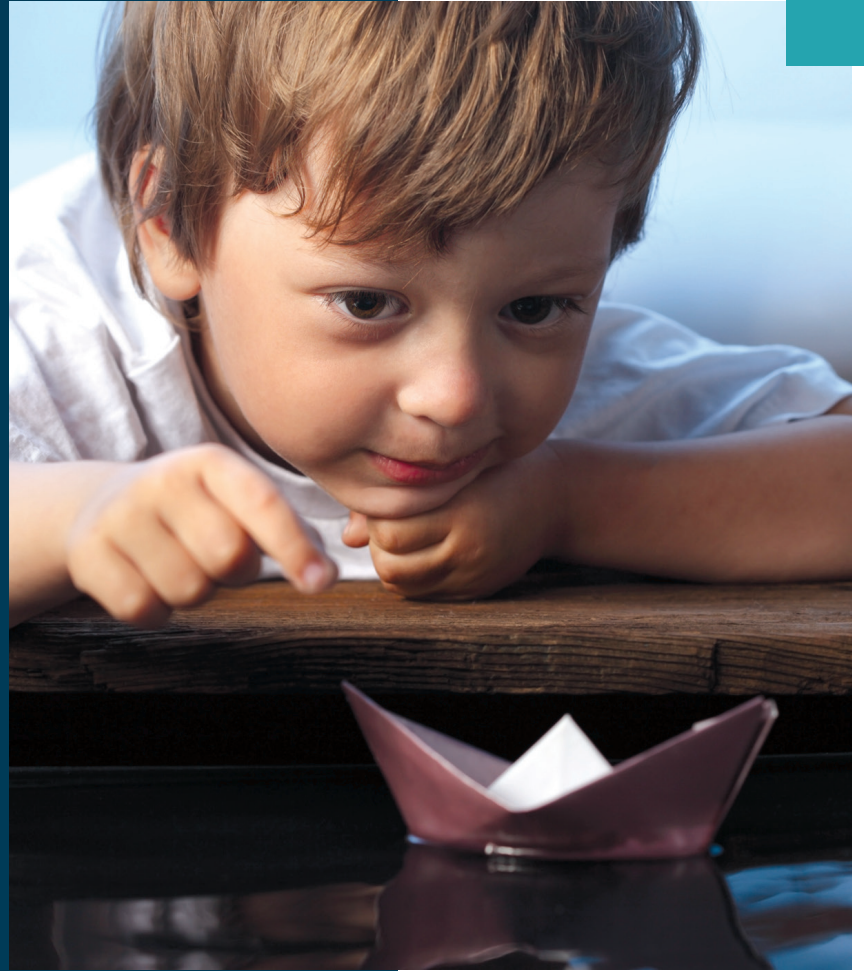

Step project

The goal of the project is to empower women economically, provide job opportunities, reduce poverty, and increase the level of income for poor families.

Where 20 women were trained in the field of sewing and then they were given 20 sewing machines to encourage them to rely on themselves and start their own projects to support their families.

A project of paving and expanding some of the rugged mountain roads in Hobeish district



In partnership with Search for Common Ground and with the support of the British Foreign Office, the Ma-Development Organization has implemented projects for paving and expanding roads in each of (power transmission - transfer of sword - transfer of Jaafara) in Hebish district, Ibb governorate. Which links isolation to the district center, that facilitated girls' access to their schools, quickly Patient access to service centers.



Project against gender-based violence

The organization, in partnership with the Yemeni Women's Union, and with the support of the United Nations Population Fund, implemented the project against gender-based violence in four directorates:
(Jablah - Al-Mishna - Al-Aden - Al-Asdah)

This project focuses on the following areas:

Rehabilitation and training of workers in the field of discovering, monitoring and evaluating cases of gender-based violence.

Rehabilitation and training of health workers to connect them with case management officers and make use of the provision of health services for abused cases.

- ▣ Establishing protection networks in every district.
- ▣ Implementing awareness sessions in the four directorates.
- ▣ Providing cash assistance to 100 cases that were exposed to gender-based violence.



A project to distribute food aid to affected and vulnerable families



The organization, with the support of Qatar Charity and a group of philanthropists, carried out a nutritional intervention that included the provision of integrated food baskets as one of the quick responses to the humanitarian situation of the poorest families in Jableh and Al-Dhahhar district in Ibb governorate.

A project to establish a child-friendly space in Jableh District

Wama organization, in partnership with INTERSOS, and with the support of UNICEF, implemented the friendly space project "The Colors of All Children", which is located in the public library in Jableh. The space aims to provide psychological and social support to children who have been subjected to stress and psychological crises due to the war, and those under the age of 18 years of all groups and ages, and the project has lasted for eight months.

The project of distributing school bags for orphans in Ibb governorate



The project targeted 200 orphans and orphans, where we held a back to school festival through which registration fees were paid to students and the distribution of (school uniform - school bag - stationery) for each student. Winter clothing (jackets - socks - gloves - hats) was also distributed to them. And sweets cut to introduce joy in them.





A project to educate families located in areas where the cholera bacterium is suspected

We have implemented a number of awareness campaigns for families living in areas where cholera germs are expected to appear in Ibb governorate. Firstly, the valley region, in which about 80 families live, and in which streams of torrents and human waste flow. Secondly, the areas that lie along the stream of torrents and garbage and garbage collections, which includes (220) families.

In partnership with the Yemeni Women Union, Wama Organization for Development implemented the distribution of the dignity bag funded by the United Nations Population Fund for (376) families who have been exposed to cases of gender-based violence as part of the organization's activities in the GBV cluster.

**A comprehensive
field survey
project for the
poorest families.**

The organization carried out a comprehensive field survey of the poorest households. The aim was to create a documented, sound and updated database that includes the poorest families in Jableh District, Ibb Governorate, and circulate it to all agencies working on the humanitarian side to ensure that everyone receives humanitarian aid without duplication and duplication, and 55 surveyors, scanners, administrators and field supervisors participated in the survey process.

Distribution of housing bags to the poorest families



With the support of ACTED, the organization implemented the distribution of (1215) shelter bags that included (650) families from the poorest families, as well as workers in the Cleaning Fund in Jabla District, Ibb Governorate.

Training and qualifying the organization's work team and youth initiatives.

We have implemented several workshops to qualify workers in youth initiatives in the field of humanitarian and community work and build development and human rights organizations.

Implementing a training bag for basic workers and volunteers in the organization that included:

- (Strategic planning - marketing - project preparation - communication and communication)
- Monitoring - Support and Advocacy - Rights and Freedoms).
- Training of the organization's team in the use of the HACT system
- Training and qualifying a group of youth initiatives on (fundamentals of development work - mobilizing support and formulating funding requests - human resources management - the unified approach to cash transfers)



Sub-grants project on issues of discrimination, violations and other human rights in Yemen.



The organization implemented the "Monitoring Project for Discrimination and Violation Cases in Yemen with a sub-grant from the European Union in five governorates (Ibb - Taiz - Al Hudaydah - Al Mahwit - Raymah) in the fields of monitoring (education - health - employment - political participation - legal aid - and various areas of violations. Its pictures and forms).



Building the institutional capacity of the members of the Ma-Development Organization.

The organization received (12) external grants to Jordan (development) and improving the institutional structure of the organization's members at the hands of experts from the PILBG Public International Law and Policy Group, which won the Nobel Peace Prize. These programs are held as a chain link for several training courses in various fields in terms of monitoring and international law. Humanitarian, human rights issues and institutional building.





Project for monitoring fair trial progress in Yemen.

With a sub-grant from the European Union, the organization implemented the project in the governorates of Ibb and Dhamar. Specific mechanisms and clear data.

Project to strengthen the ways of peace in Yemen

The organization, with a sub-grant from PILBG, implemented the project to strengthen the ways of peace in Yemen by implementing a set of successive activities, including printing a set of posters, awareness notebooks, short flashes, and social media posts to raise awareness of the importance of peacebuilding in Yemen.

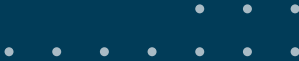
Field research was also carried out on measuring the community's views on the importance of building peace in Yemen and the proposed mechanisms for that.





Humanitarian and relief support.

1. The organization, with the support of philanthropists, provided financial grants to (80) distressed families.
2. Implementing a participatory entertainment workshop for 80 separated and unaccompanied children and orphans in Dar Al-Rahma, in order to encourage children to express their desires and dreams through free drawing to convey their messages to the surrounding community and relevant parties.





Humanitarian and relief support.

1. The organization, through self-efforts and with the support of philanthropists, provided capital to a group of displaced people with the aim of empowering them economically after losing their small projects. Among these projects:
2. A- Financing the project for knitting the weave, "which is a type of Yemeni folk costume that concerns the youth and adults"
3. B - Financing a project to equip a mini-cafeteria in front of a school to prepare snacks for students.
4. Providing monthly assistance in the amount of 30,000 riyals per month to the 8 poorest families, through a philanthropist.





Environmental Sanitation Programs

Implementing a cleaning campaign that included most of the garbage and rubbish collection points in the city of Jableh, with the aim of disposing of the waste causing the spread of diseases.

In addition, the organization, in partnership with several institutions and civil society organizations, and in cooperation with the Cleanliness and Improvement Fund, carried out a cleaning campaign that included the districts of Al-Dhahar and Al-Shamna, during which awareness campaigns were carried out in some schools of the two directorates and some university departments.

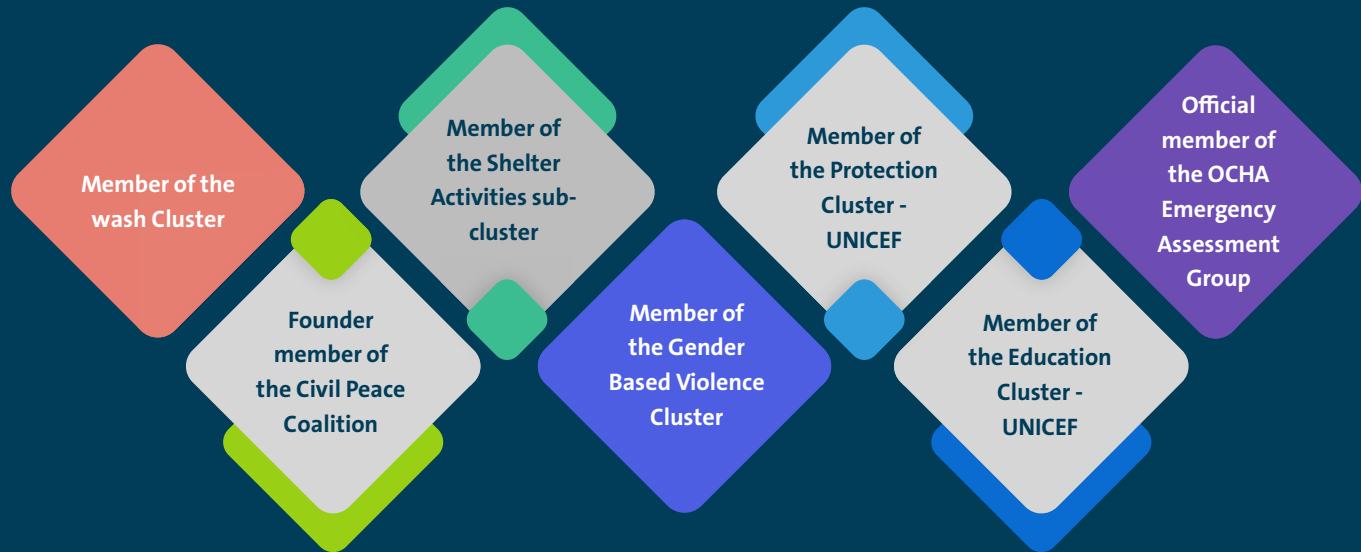
